

PURCHASING AND CONTRACTING POLICY

At **Wind Service Hub, S.L.** We believe that the correct management of purchases and contracts is essential to guarantee the quality, safety and sustainability of the services we offer. Our policy is aimed at ensuring that all goods, infrastructures, services and subcontracted works are acquired or contracted with suppliers that comply with the highest technical, legal and ethical standards.

Purchasing and contracting decisions are governed by the following principles:

- **Compliance with contractual and regulatory requirements:** All products and services must comply with applicable legislation, applicable regulatory standards and the requirements of the Wind Service Hub ISO management system.
- **Transparency and objectivity:** all acquisitions are made in a documented manner and with objective criteria, guaranteeing equal treatment of suppliers.
- **Quality and continuous improvement:** only suppliers are hired to ensure compliance with the established technical and quality requirements.
- **Sustainability and environmental responsibility:** priority is given to the acquisition of products and services that reduce environmental impact and promote resource efficiency.
- **Occupational health and safety:** all suppliers are required to strictly comply with occupational risk prevention regulations and to accredit the training of their workers.

Wind Service Hub has a documented supplier **assessment, selection, and monitoring process**, which determines their Suitability before establishing business relationships.

The evaluation criteria include:

- Compliance with **initial** legal, technical and administrative requirements.
- Performance in **quality, environment and occupational safety**.
- History of **non-conformities** or incidents.

Only suppliers with a favourable evaluation and who meet the minimum requirements are considered **approved suppliers**.

Purchases and contracts that affect the quality of the service are made **exclusively with approved suppliers**.

Suppliers may request the result of their evaluation by writing to the company's contact address.
